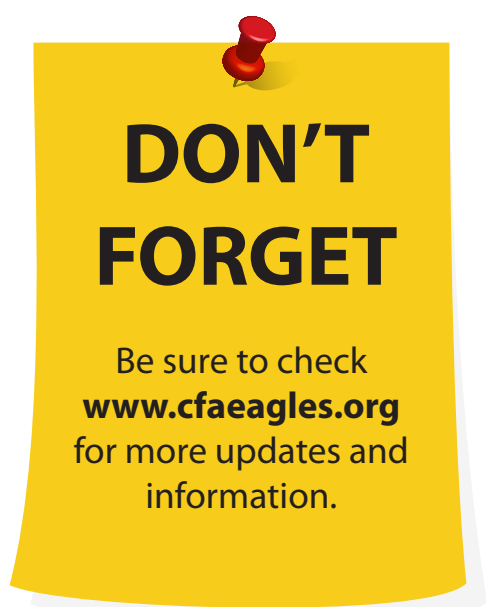
## 5 PAYMENTS
